Sprinkler repairs for Chadsworth common areas is still ongoing. As of June, 75% of the repairs have been completed with a cost of \$5000 so far.

The new well in the playground area is now complete. The HOA is now looking for drainage solutions for that area.

Tree in the common areas: In the final stages of getting dead trees removed and trimming up other limbs.

New Trees: Sponsor to take care of a new trees in the common area. New trees need care and attention. The HOA would like to replace the trees we have lost in the common areas but only if individual's agree to sponsor the tree and care for it over the next few years. Geese Problem: We are continuing to working on the overpopulation of geese problem. We handed out flyers from the Department of Park and Recreation to homeowners on the lake. We have the Do Not Feed the Geese or Ducks signs in place to help reduce the number of geese and ducks on the lakes. We legally addled the goose eggs last May. But most of all we need to remind neighbors not to feed the geese.

Chadsworth has a new mowing service this year. Avant Lawn and Landscaping. We are saving \$11,000 this year with the new mowing service.
